Changes to Employer Superannuation Contribution Tax (ESCT)

Legislation was passed in December 2020 increasing ESCT, that is the rate of tax paid by employers on employer contributions to **defined benefit superannuation schemes** such as GSF, from 33% to 39% with effect from 1 April 2021.

The employer contribution rates payable to GSF are advised to you inclusive of ESCT. The current employer contribution rates, advised to you in early 2020, are inclusive of ESCT at 33%.

Employer contribution rates are determined annually by the Authority's Actuary and would usually be is due to change from 1 July 2021.

The Authority has agreed that, instead of implementing two changes to the employer rate this year - one at 1 April 2021 to accommodate the ESCT change and one at 1 July 2021 as a result of the annual review, only one change will apply incorporating both changes.

Your employer contribution rate to GSF will therefore change this year from 1 April 2021.

You will need to implement the change to the employer contribution rate to GSF and you may also need to change your payroll system for the new ESCT rate of 39%.

Changes to employer contribution rates for GSF require ministerial approval. We will advise you of your new employer contribution rate as soon as ministerial approval is received. We expect this to be in late January/early February 2021.

A separate newsletter is being prepared for members as they may be impacted by the change if they are on total remuneration packages.
